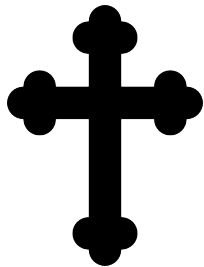

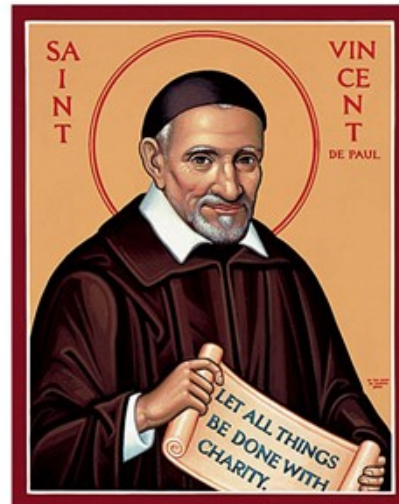

Our Mission

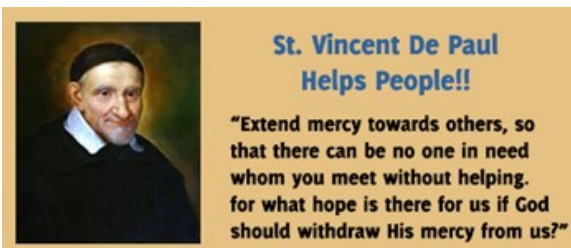
