You've seen the pictures of crumbled buildings and displaced Christians on the evening news.

Since 2014, the Knights of Columbus have raised more than \$10.5 million for relief, assisting Christians and other internally displaced persons and refugees in Iraq, Syria, Jordan and Lebanon. The Knights have partnered to provide general relief, food, clothing, shelter, education and medical care.

“Our efforts are a concrete response to Pope Francis’ request for prayers and material assistance for those affected by this terrible persecution,” explained Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson. “We are asking our members, and all people of good will, to pray for those persecuted and to support our efforts to assist them by donating to this fund.”
