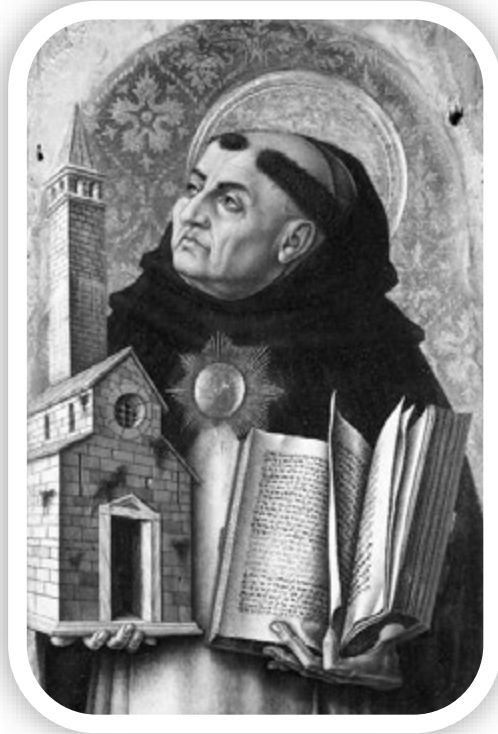

Dear Parishioners,

His Holiness, Pope Pius XII was Bishop of Rome; Dwight D. Eisenhower was President of the United States; the Milwaukee Braves won the World Series; *Around the World in 80 Days* took the Oscar for Best Picture; *All Shook Up* by Elvis Presley rose to the top of Billboard's chart; and on May 12, 1957, His Excellency, Archbishop John O'Hara, dedicated St. Thomas Aquinas Church, Croydon. Much has changed since that date, but St. Thomas Aquinas Parish continues to be an instrument of God's grace to the local community. Today we give praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God for the blessings, help, and comfort that he has bestowed upon us in this house over the past sixty years!

Before we move into the summer months, I want to express my gratitude to all those who have given so generously of their time, talent, and treasure to this parish. I am grateful to the Knights of Columbus and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus for their very generous combined donation of \$3000 which helped substantially reduce the per person cost of our Sixtieth Anniversary Dinner. In addition, the Knights picked up the entire cost of repair to our electronic sign on Bristol Pike, and the Ladies donated the floral decorations for the Sixtieth Anniversary Mass. Also, both organizations jointly sponsored the St. Francis of Assisi play.

A number of organizations will be adjourning for the summer: Prep, Choir, Children's Liturgy of the Word, Church Breakfast, and Church Social, Pastoral Council, and Finance Council. I am grateful for the good work they do. I am also thankful for all those who helped in various ways to enrich our Holy Week and Easter experience.

I continue to work with the Pastoral and Finance Councils to address our challenging financial situation:

- Lottery tickets have now been on sale for a couple of weeks. Those who buy a ticket have a chance to win for a whole year! The more tickets you buy, the better your chances of winning.
- An increase offertory letter should have reached you by now. Any increase you can afford—no matter how big or small—will help us to reduce our deficit.
- Volunteers are urgently needed for a monthly parish bingo! If you can help, please call the office ASAP. We need both men and women to help!
- The school building is being actively marketed, but, unfortunately, no one has expressed an interest yet. Keep up the prayers!
- The appeal against the closure of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is still in process! A final verdict is expected by the beginning of next year. No guarantees though!

Enjoy the summer. Take a rest from work and school. Never take a vacation from God! My friend, Google, knows where the nearest Catholic Church is located. Don't forget that your parish still depends on your continued generosity—even when you are not here. May God continue to bless this parish so that some of us may one day gather to celebrate the one hundredth anniversary of the dedication of St. Thomas Aquinas Church!

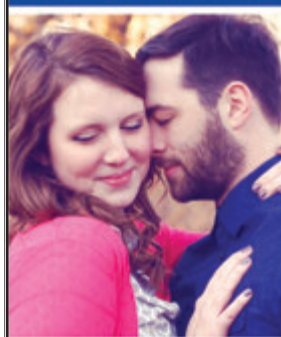
