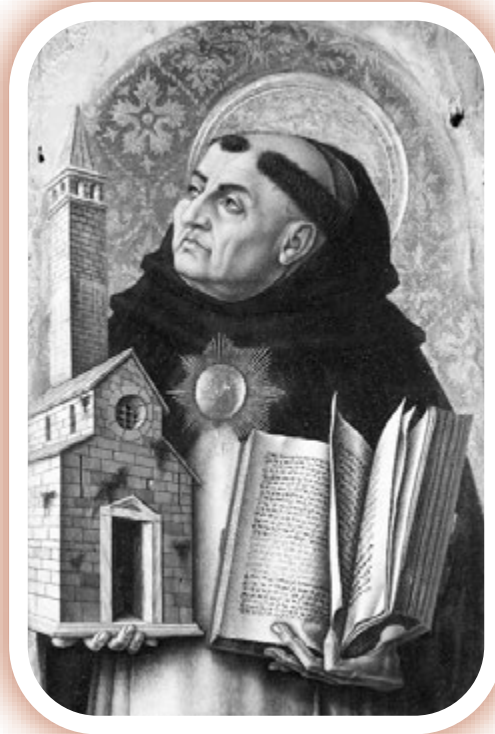

Welcome back from your summer holidays, and greetings from the Emerald Isle! Before I get to upcoming events, I must express my gratitude to those who labored during the summer months on behalf of the parish. Thanks to all those who weeded, planted, and watered our parish gardens. I especially enjoyed the tomatoes and peppers—still waiting for the figs! Also, kudos goes to those who put together another successful Parish Picnic. Nothing like an organic-acorn fed, Iberico pig! Not to forget Marie Jensen who was hard at work painting our nativity set and David Zimmerman who skillfully pieced together the broken statue of St. Joseph.

There are plenty of events coming up in the next few months to keep everyone occupied:

- Sunday Breakfast and Sunday Social will resume this month. Breakfast is usually the second Sunday of the month, and Social is usually the fourth Sunday of the month.
- The Knights of Columbus will be running their annual golf outing on Saturday, September 15th at the Bensalem Country Club.
- The Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus will host a Wine and Cheese Social on Monday, September 17th for those interested in becoming members.
- The Blessing of the Animals will take place Sunday, October 7th at 12:30 PM. Bring your dogs, cats, reptiles, bugs, and rocks. I'll be watching from the safety of my room!
- The Malvern Retreat Center is sending Kathleen McCarthy to conduct a Morning of Recollection on Saturday, November 3rd. Her reflections will focus on John 3:16.
- Saturday, November 3rd at 4:30 PM is the parish Memorial Mass—a time to remember and pray for the happy repose of the souls of those who have died in the last twelve months.
- On Sunday, November 4th the Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus is sponsoring their annual Soup and Conversation. Try using chicken feet in your soup—yum!
- November 18th is the annual Christmas Bazaar. Shop till you drop!
- The annual parish Christmas Community and Unity Dinner is set for Saturday, December 1st. Only a few months till Christmas!

Before I conclude, here is the latest news:

- ◇ “Christmas in July” raised almost \$1500 which will be used for the needs of the poor in the area during December.
- ◇ 416 lottery tickets were sold this year—fewer than the 504 sold last year.
- ◇ Nothing new to report on the status of the former St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish’s appeal to Rome.
- ◇ We had an offer to rent the school, but the Archdiocese of Philadelphia withheld their approval. They felt that the proposed use would have competed with the educational programs at St. Charles and St. Ephrem.
- ◇ We have a new parish fundraiser: 50/50. Buy as many tickets as you want at \$5 each. The cost of the tickets is not a tax deductible donation. Please write separate collection and 50/50 checks. The drawing will be in December. Start dreaming about how you will spend it all!
- ◇ Although you may have taken a summer vacation, the parish expenses didn’t! They include:
 - * 8 New Air Conditioning Units for the Hall, Chapel, and Church Sound Room: \$57,574
 - * Repairs to the Roofs at Seton and St. Thomas: \$6,929
 - * Repairs to the Sidewalk and Rectory Steps at St. Thomas: \$6,475
 - * Parking Lot Repairs at both Properties: \$3,813
 - * New Carpeting in St. Thomas Church and Repairs to the Existing Carpeting: \$2,000
- ◇ Most of our Pastoral and Finance Council members have been serving for a few years now. I would like to see some turnover in membership. Please think about nominating parishioners to serve on these two parish organizations. I will follow up at a later date with more information.

Welcome back! Get involved! Support your parish with your time, talent, and treasure, and pray for a return of the majority to the practice of their Faith!
