APRIL is *National* *Child Abuse Prevention Month*



On Sunday, April 28, Children's Faith Formation will join hundreds of other churches across the nation to pray for the victims of child abuse and for those who rescue them. This day is better known as **Blue Sunday**. The National Blue Sunday Day of Prayer began in 1994 with only 20 participating churches but has now grown to include 7.4 million participants on five continents.

In recognition of Blue Sunday, we are encouraging all catechists and children to wear blue on April 28. Additionally, Youth Ministry will be serving blueberry muffins as part of Sunday Food & Fellowship. Each child will be sent home with a flyer containing the Blue Sunday Prayer and information on how recognize the signs of child abuse.

We will also have a sea of blue pinwheels out in front of the Community Center (weather permitting) that will be available for purchase at \$1/each. All proceeds will go to the Dallas Child Advocacy Center.
