*SWIMMING LESSONS FOR 1ST-5TH GRADERS:* Parents will need to send swimsuits and towels daily beginning Tuesday, May 14. We prefer our girls to wear one-piece swimsuits designed to be modest. Each day the children will take home their swimsuits and towels and bring back the dry suits/towels Tuesday through Friday. Please don't buy special items. Students will change here before riding the bus over to the pool and should wear a t-shirt or cover-up on the bus over the swimsuits with their school shoes or flip flops.
