Annual Catholic Appeal

As most everyone remembers, the Annual Catholic Appeal was held late this past year because of the One Campaign. Now it is nearly upon us and the first Appeal weekend will be January 24th and 25th.

Coming so soon after the holidays and seeming to have just ended, it becomes all the more important to remember the intent and importance of the Appeal and the role we serve as the Catholic faithful.

I've taken the liberty of sharing some excerpts from Evangelium Gaudium, Pope Francis' first apostolic work, that underpin the challenge-and the joy-the Holy Father has laid before us:

187. Each individual Christian and every community is called to be an instrument of God for the liberation and promotion of the poor, and for enabling them to be fully a part of society. This demands that we be docile and attentive to the cry of the poor and to come to their aid.

188. In this context, we can understand Jesus' command to his disciples: "You yourselves give them something to eat!" (Mk 6:37); it means working to eliminate the structural causes of poverty and to promote the integral development of the poor, as well as small daily acts of solidarity in meeting the real needs which we encounter.

191. In all places and circumstances, Christians, with the help of their pastors, are called to hear the cry of the poor... Seeing their poverty, hearing their cries and knowing their sufferings, we are scandalized because we know that there is enough food for everyone and that hunger is the result of a poor distribution of goods and income.

The Annual Catholic Appeal is not just about the poor because the Appeal funds many other important works such as the education of seminarians and tuition assistance for Catholic schools. And it serves local people as well. As we listen to the words of Bishop Soto during Appeal Sunday, think of the times especially lately when you witness the needs around us locally. The need is real-and the resources are within our grasp.

Please be generous-as you always have been-and support Father Ambrose and the Bishop in this important mission, and recognize that in doing so, we are helping Pope Francis serve God's people.
