Suspension of Eucharistic Cup Lifted

The Diocese of Sacramento, Office of Worship, has just lifted temporary suspension of the Eucharistic Cup.

According to the California Department of Public Health influenza surveillance report, the number of influenza-like illnesses has dropped below the epidemic threshold levels for two consecutive weeks. The Diocese of Sacramento established this benchmark as an objective standard to gauge the risk of infection. We are now free to resume normal liturgical practices including the administration of the Blood of Christ, and shaking hands at the sign of peace. At the same time, please use common sense in receiving Holy Communion. If you are ill and might be contagious, please abstain from Eucharistic cup.
