2018 Disaster Emergency Collection (Un Colección Para Emergencia de Catástrofe en 2018) November 4, 2018

Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, president of the USCCB has invited the bishops of the United States to take an emergency collection in response to the recent devastation caused by Hurricane Florence and the 7.5 magnitude earthquake and tsunami that struck Indonesia. In anticipation of more calamities awaiting us this year, funds collected through this collection will also be used to provide relief for possible future disasters that occur this year.

The funds collected from the Emergency Collection for 2018 Disasters will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA, Catholic Relief Services, and US Conference of Catholic Bishops as they reach out to provide humanitarian aid in the form of water, food, shelter, medical care and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery as well as for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church in the United States and around the world.
