From the Office of the Bishop

Dear Friends in Christ,

On Monday, November 12th, I will join my brother bishops for the week-long assembly of the US Conference of Catholic Bishops. At this meeting, we will make critical decisions regarding the scourge of sex abuse by clergy in our Church. I pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us to act as vigilant guardians of the young and vulnerable in our Church.

Each bishop must confront the past and the shameful history of priests and bishops who betrayed the trust placed in them by the People of God. Children and young people were scarred by horrible and wicked crimes committed by the very people they had been taught to rely on as spiritual leaders. We must seek atonement for these sins and work continually to be worthy of the trust God's people. Only after such atonement can we expect there to be confidence in the measures we take to safeguard the vulnerable in our parishes, schools, and ministries.

To prepare for this assembly, I ask all of you to join me in prayer for three intentions:

- *For the healing and support of all victims of the clergy sexual abuse.
- *For the conversion and just punishment of the perpetrators and concealers of sexual abuse.
- *For the strength of the bishops to be holy shepherds in protecting and leading God's people from harm.

Thank you for all your prayers. Please know that I am grateful for them, and that I hold you in my prayers as well.

Estimados Amigos en Cristo,

El lunes, 12 de noviembre, me reuniré con mis hermanos obispos durante la semana de la asamblea de la Conferencia Episcopal Católica de los Estados Unidos. En esta reunión, tomaremos decisiones críticas con respecto al abuso sexual por parte del clero en nuestra Iglesia.
