Bishop Jaime Soto Releases Statement and Words of Consolation following Camp Fire

Bishop Jaime Soto says, "The tremendous loss from the Camp Fire ravaging parts of the diocese is devastating. The families in Paradise and the surrounding communities affected by the fire can rely on the support of our prayers. We also pray for the brave men and women responding to this disaster and battling the fires. May all those who have died in this catastrophic inferno be granted eternal repose in the merciful hands of the Lord Jesus."

St. Thomas More Parish in Paradise was in the direct line of the fire. Reports indicate that all parishioners have evacuated the area, though many have lost their homes. The Diocese has confirmed that St. Thomas More Church and school buildings have survived the fire. The new rectory, old rectory, and parish hall were destroyed.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul and Northern Valley Catholic Social Service are actively collaborating with partner organizations on local relief and recovery efforts.

As of November 13, fire crews are still battling the fire and it is only 30% contained. "I give thanks to the fire fighters and first responders for all they are doing to save our parishioners and the community," says Father Godwin Xavier, Parochial Administrator of St. Thomas More Parish.

El Obispo Jaime Soto Emite un Comunicado y Palabras de Consuelo Después del Incendio "Camp Fire"

El Obispo Jaime Soto diga, "La tremenda pérdida por los destrozos del "Camp Fire" en partes de la diócesis es devastadora. Las familias en Paradise y las comunidades aledañas afectadas por el fuego pueden contar con el apoyo de nuestras oraciones. También oramos por los hombres y mujeres valientes que responden a este desastre y luchan contra los incendios. Que a todos los que murieron en este fuego catastrófico se les conceda el reposo eterno en las manos misericordiosas de Nuestro Señor Jesús".

La Diócesis ha confirmado que las estructuras de la iglesia y la escuela de St. Thomas More han sobrevivido al incendio. La rectoría nueva, la rectoría antigua y el salón parroquial fueron destruidos.

La Sociedad de San Vicente de Paul y el Servicio Social Católico del Valle del Norte, están colaborando activamente con las organizaciones asociadas en los esfuerzos locales de socorro y recuperación.

Hasta el 13 de noviembre, los equipos de bomberos todavía están luchando contra los incendios y se ha contenido solamente un 30%. "Doy las gracias a los bomberos y socorristas por todo lo que están haciendo para salvar a nuestros feligreses y a la comunidad", dice el Padre Godwin Xavier, Administrador Parroquial de la parroquia St. Thomas More.
