What is the Mass or Liturgy? Part #1

A good way to describe the Mass is to say that it is Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday made present today in ritual. It is not merely a meal which reminds us of the Last Supper, or a Passion play which helps recall Good Friday, or a Sunrise Service which celebrate the Lord's Resurrection. On our Walk Through the Mass we will see ritual acts of 1) Gathering, 2) Liturgy of the Word, 3) Liturgy of the Eucharist, and 4) Commissioning or Recessional.
