TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus (CE) are good options for all classes. This will be a good investment and will be used in advanced math classes. \*\*Precalculus and Calculus must have a graphing calculator.

Supplies: pencil, red pen, calculator...recommend TI-83 or TI-84 (avoid TI-89 and TI-92 as they are prohibited on the ACT exam)

\*Geometry classes will also need a protractor, compass, and straightedge.

Scientific calculator use for science and algebra (Scientific calculators have keys for SIN, COS, and Tan). The freshman science/math teachers recommend the following models: TI-30XIIB, TI-30XIIS, and TI-30XA. These are all low cost, usually available, and are easy to use.

Centimeter ruler (30 cm in length) clear, (see through) plastic are best!! (Science). You may want to buy more than one. Many freshmen lose or break a ruler during the school year.
