But he told the people that the one to come would baptize with the Holy Spirit and with fire (see Luke 3:15–16).


Look at the first row of words in the river.

In today's Gospel we hear the voice from heaven call Jesus "my beloved Son" (Luke 3:15-16, 21-22). It tells us that Jesus is the Son of God.

With words and signs the Church reminds us of God's love for us, and the ways in which we must always try to act as a child of God. Connect the symbols with the prayers used in the Rite of Baptism that describe how we are to live as a chosen child of God.




See in this white garment

and of the Holy Spirit.





Ask your family to share with you their memories of the day you were baptized.
