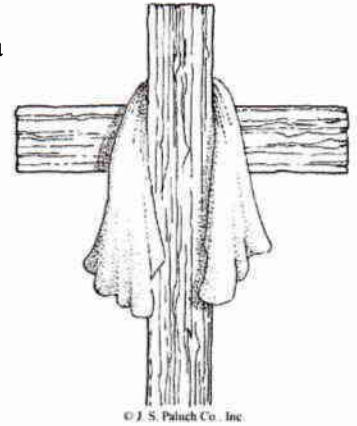

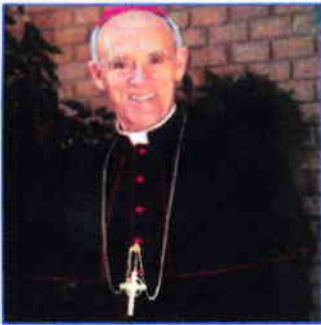

Edmond Carmody, (born 12 January 1934) Carmody was educated in Ireland at St. Brendan's Seminary and at St. Patrick's College He was ordained a priest on 8 June 1957 for the then Diocese of San Antonio. In 1968 he received a master's degree in education from Our Lady of the Lake University and in 1973 a master's degree in social work.

Bishop Carmody was installed as ordinary of the *Diocese of Tyler* on May 25, 1992, where he served as bishop for eight years. He was installed Bishop of the Diocese of Corpus Christi on March 17, 2000. Upon his reaching the age limit for an acting bishop, he became bishop emeritus. After serving the Diocese of Corpus Christi for over ten years he was invited to return to the Diocese of Tyler. Carmody served as the Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia until 2015. He has since returned to the Diocese of Corpus Christi.

Edmond Carmody (nacido el 12 de enero de 1934) Carmody se educó en Irlanda en el Seminario de San Brendan y en el Colegio de San Patricio. Fue ordenado sacerdote el 8 de junio de 1957 para la entonces diócesis de San Antonio. En 1968 recibió una maestría en educación de la Universidad de Nuestra Señora del Lago y en 1973 una maestría en trabajo social.

El obispo Carmody se instaló como ordinario de la Diócesis de Tyler el 25 de mayo de 1992. Donde sirvió como obispo durante ocho años. Fue instalado obispo de la Diócesis de Corpus Christi el 17 de marzo de 2000. Al alcanzar el límite de edad para un obispo en funciones, se convirtió en obispo emérito. Después de servir en la Diócesis de Corpus Christi durante más de diez años, fue invitado a regresar a la Diócesis de Tyler. Carmody se desempeñó como Vicario General y Moderador de la Curia hasta 2015. Desde entonces, ha regresado a la Diócesis de Corpus Christi.
