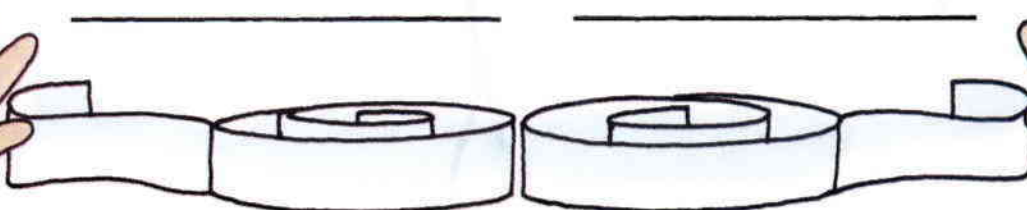

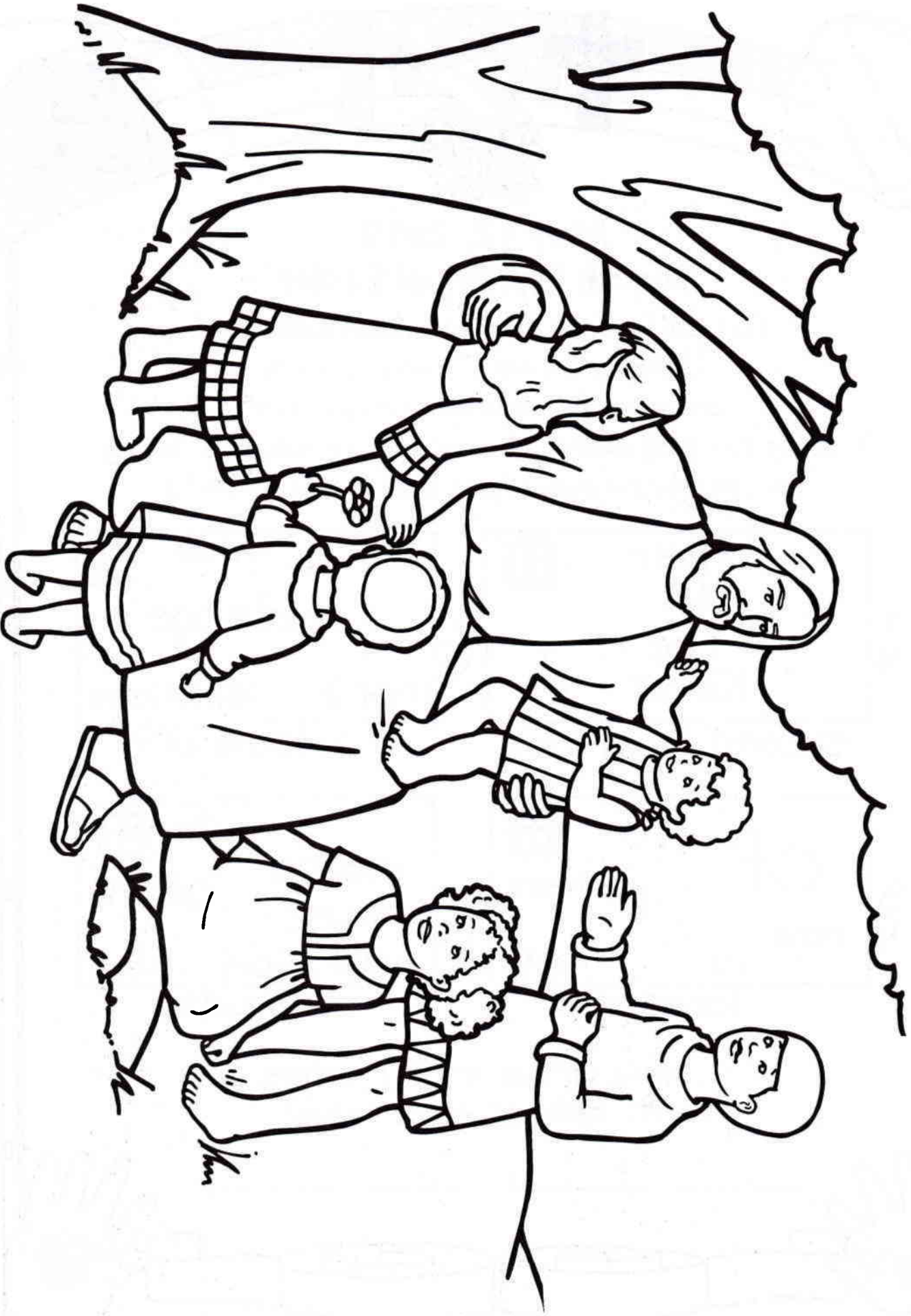

MY SHEEP HEAR MY VOICE

On the Fourth Sunday of Easter we always hear a Gospel story about the Good Shepherd. The one we read today (John 10:27–30) is especially reassuring because Jesus tells his followers, “My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. . . No one can take them out of my hand” (John 10:27, 29).

Today is also Mother’s Day. What do you like best about your mother’s voice? Does she have special names for you? Does she like to use a special phrase or sentence when she speaks to you? Jesus, the Good Shepherd, tells us that if we listen, we will hear his voice. That voice often sounds like the voice of someone who loves us and cares for us. It can be our mother’s or the voice of others who share their love with us.

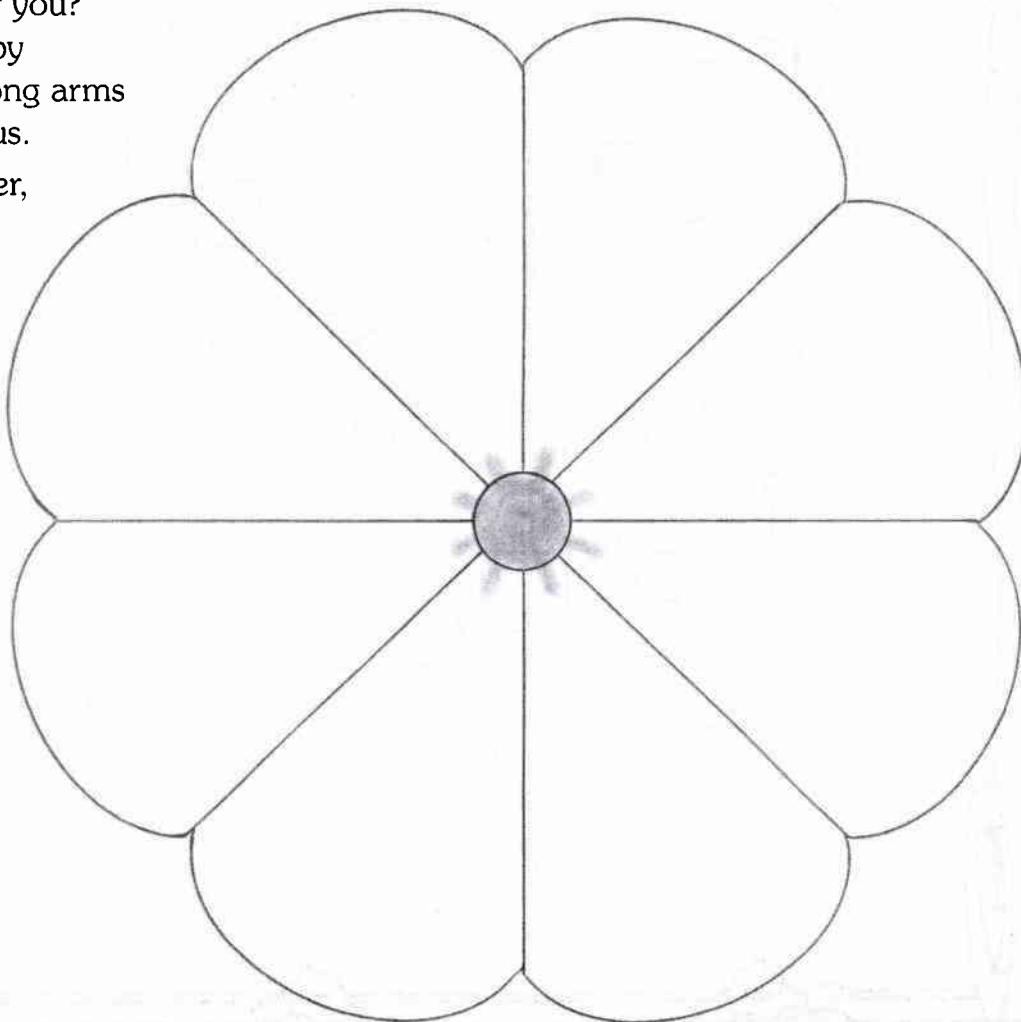
Jesus also says that we are safe with him; no one can take us from him. How does your mother protect and care for you?
