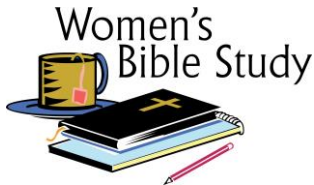




CHURCH OFFICE

Sunday's Reflections
James 2:1-5

GETTING TO KNOW THE POOR

If a beautiful person walks past you, you may do a double-take. It's human. When you make new friends at school, you'll try first the ones with an attractive appearance.

And if you hear that someone is rich, you'll want to get to know that person. We're always curious to know who has money, and to become their friends—just in case.

Even at church, we probably give more attention to those who have than we do to those who have not. It's human. And it's wrong.

The Letter to James cannot stand this hypocrisy. "If a man with gold rings and fine clothes comes into your assembly, and a poor person in shabby clothes also comes in," James knows what will happen. You'll pay more attention to the rich than you will to the poor. If we do that, we "become judges with evil designs."

James appeals to us on behalf of the poor. "Did not God choose those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom that he promised to those who love him?" The poor often have a deeper faith, a stronger dependence on God, and a keener insight into the Spirit than do the rich. We owe them our respect.

When you have the opportunity, don't try to meet someone with money. Get to know someone who has less. You will receive a greater reward.
