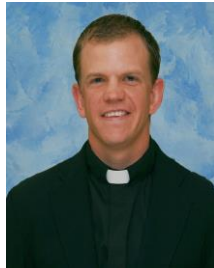

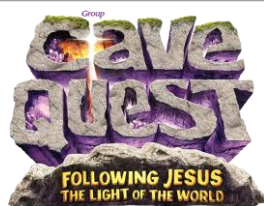

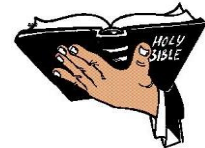

**Sunday's Reflections**  
*Galatians 1:11-19*

**PRIVATE REVELATION, PUBLIC MINISTRY**

Prayer can reveal things in a way that study and conversation cannot. In the spiritual life, we use any means at our disposal to learn God's will and to obtain the strength to do it. We worship with the community. We serve others. We learn about our faith through journals, talks and dialogue.

But private prayer has a hallowed place in any spiritual life. There we bring ourselves to God, and there, God speaks to our hearts.

In his Letter to the Galatians, Paul reports the conversion of heart he experienced when Jesus Christ revealed himself. Paul grew up as a zealous believer who progressed in his knowledge of Judaism. When the followers of Jesus began to form a church, Paul was among those who tried to destroy them.

But God had set Paul apart while still in his mother's womb, and revealed Jesus to him. Paul says about the gospel, "I did not receive it from a human being, nor was I taught it, but it came through a revelation of Jesus Christ." Only later did he meet Peter and James in Jerusalem. At first, his entire knowledge of Christ and his commission to travel and preach came from this revelation.

Our private prayer is rarely as dramatic as Paul's. But it can bring similar results. We become convinced of the gospel, firm in our faith, and anxious to put it into action.
