**Sunday's Reflections**  
1 Thessalonians 1:5c-10

**SPREAD THE WORD**

When faith takes root, it spreads. When you are truly touched by the mercy of God, you tell other people. You share your faith. They come to believe because of your testimony.

In the business world, customers are some of the best agents for selling products. If you really like something you have bought, you tell other people and inspire them to get it too. In the secular world, this is a form of evangelization.

Paul, Timothy, and Silvanus, writing to the Thessalonians, complimented them on their faith. It had taken root and it was spreading. The Thessalonians were telling the world about Christ. “For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth not only in Macedonia and in Achaia, but in every place your faith in God has gone forth.”

The Thessalonians had received the word in great affliction, and it brought them tremendous comfort. They shared their faith with others who needed to hear this gospel of hope as well.

People undergoing any affliction may find comfort from the gospel of Jesus, whom God raised from the dead and who delivers us from all adversity. If you have experienced peace through faith, and if you know someone suffering some affliction, you can do the world a favor. Proclaim the peace of Jesus Christ. Faith has taken root in your heart. Let it spread.
