Sunday's Reflections 2 Corinthians 4:13—5:1

A PEACEFUL DYING

Before they die, some people attain peace. Others don't. They are angry about their illness, disappointed about work left undone, envious of those who survive, and regretful about the past. But some, blessedly, are thankful for their life, their family, the opportunities of the past, and the promise of future glory.

Paul, the apostle, could tell he was growing older. He was not able to do all that he formerly did. But he was grateful for another blessing of aging—seeing the fruit of his work. "Although our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day," he writes. He firmly believed that "what is seen is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal." So he accepted "this momentary light affliction," knowing it would ultimately produce "an eternal weight of glory."

How did Paul attain this peace? He had experienced the risen Jesus. He believed that God had raised Jesus from the dead, and that God would also raise believers with Jesus, placing them in his presence. "Therefore," he says, "we are not discouraged."

Christ appears to us in many ways throughout our lives—in our prayer and in our service, in the witness of family and friends, in the flecks of glory that shimmer with every dawn, and in the undying hope that sees beyond a setting sun. Jesus lives. He calls us to his side. We are not discouraged.
