Filipenses 3: 8-14
HACIENDO SIN

En algún momento, tenemos que prescindir. Si viajamos, prescindimos de todo lo que no cabe en el equipaje. Si nos enfermamos, lo hacemos sin la energía que nos gusta tener. Si alguien a quien amamos muere, lo hacemos sin la compañía cercana que disfrutamos durante tanto tiempo.

Cuando entramos en los últimos días de la Cuaresma, nuestras mentes recurren a los últimos días de la vida de Jesús. En el ministerio, Jesús disfrutó del compañerismo de los discípulos, la cálida acogida de las familias que se preocupaban por ellos, la adulación de grandes multitudes y la apreciación de aquellos a quienes había sanado. Él tenía sus enemigos, pero su vida tenía sentido, y su oración al Padre era rica.

Al final, sin embargo, Jesús tuvo que prescindir. Sus amigos se volvieron contra él o lo abandonaron. Sufrió encarcelamiento, falsos testigos y torturas. Fue clavado en una cruz en una muerte espantosa.

Nadie quiere pasar por algo así. Pero de alguna manera, cada vez que sufrimos una pérdida, nuestros sufrimientos son aligerados por la memoria de Jesús.

Pablo escribe a los filipenses: "Por amor de Cristo Jesús nuestro Señor, he aceptado la pérdida de todas las cosas, dependiendo de la fe para conocerlo y el poder de la resurrección y el compartir sus sufrimientos al estar conformado a su muerte, si de alguna manera puedo obtener la resurrección de entre los muertos." Podemos prescindir si creemos que algún día lo haremos con la resurrección de Jesucristo.

Sunday's Reflections
Philippians 3:8-14
DOING WITHOUT

At some point, we have to do without. If we travel, we do without whatever won't fit in the luggage. If we get sick, we do without the energy we like to have. If someone we love dies, we do without the close companionship we enjoyed for so long.

As we enter the final days of Lent, our minds turn to the final days of Jesus' life. In ministry, Jesus enjoyed the companionship of disciples, the warm reception of caring households, the adulation of large crowds, and the appreciation of those he healed. He had his enemies, but his life had meaning, and his prayer to the Father was rich.

At the end, though, Jesus had to do without. His friends turned against him or abandoned him. He suffered imprisonment, false witnesses, and torture. He was nailed to a cross in a gruesome death.

No one wants to go through anything like that. But somehow, whenever we suffer a loss, our sufferings are lightened by the memory of Jesus.

Paul writes to the Philippians, "For the sake of Christ Jesus our Lord, I have accepted the loss of all things, depending on faith to know him and the power of the resurrection and the sharing of his sufferings by being conformed to his death, if somehow I may attain the resurrection from the dead." We can do without if we believe someday we will do with the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
