**Reflexiones del domingo**
*Apocalipsis 5: 11-14*
**SLAIN Y VICTORIOSO LAMB**

La Pascua celebra la resurrección de Jesús, y también proclama la fe de la iglesia en la resurrección de los cristianos. La muerte se perfila como el destino temible de toda vida humana, pero la Pascua elimina la finalidad de la muerte y abre una visión más amplia. Es difícil imaginar que un solo evento pueda tener tal efecto en la historia humana, pero ese fue el significado de la resurrección de Jesús.

Una imagen del Libro de la Revelación ilustra el punto. Juan vio una gran multitud de ángeles que rodeaban el trono y las criaturas vivientes y los ancianos. Allí cantaron alabanzas a un cordero, un cordero muerto. En la historia de los animales, ningún cordero muerto ha dejado nunca una marca en el mundo. Pero este lo hizo. El Cordero es Jesús: muerto, pero de pie y recibiendo la alabanza de todos los seres vivos.

Un cordero entró por primera vez en nuestra tradición religiosa como un símbolo de la Pascua. La noche antes del éxodo de Israel de Egipto, las fieles familias judías sacrificaron un cordero y frotaron su sangre en los postes de sus puertas. Se les ahorró lo peor de las plagas, la muerte de los primogénitos. Esa plaga finalmente forzó la mano del faraón y liberó a la gente.

Jesucristo aparece en el Apocalipsis como un Cordero inmolado. Su sangre nos protege del daño de la muerte y nos libera del pecado. A través de su muerte y resurrección, él nos ha traído el perdón y nos abrió un camino a través de la muerte a la vida.

**Sunday's Reflections**
*Revelation 5:11-14*
**SLAIN AND VICTORIOUS LAMB**

Easter celebrates the resurrection of Jesus, and it also proclaims the church's faith in the resurrection of Christians. Death looms as the fearful fate of every human life, but Easter removes the finality of death and opens a broader vision. It is hard to imagine that one single event could have such an effect on human history, but that was the meaning of Jesus' resurrection.

An image from the Book of Revelation illustrates the point. John saw a huge crowd of angels who surrounded the throne and the living creatures and the elders. There they sang praise to a Lamb—a dead lamb. In the history of animals, no dead lamb has ever left much of a mark on the world. But this one did. The Lamb is Jesus—slain, but standing, and receiving the praise of all living things.

A lamb first entered our religious tradition as a symbol of Passover. On the night before Israel's exodus from Egypt, faithful Jewish families slaughtered a lamb and rubbed its blood on their doorposts. They were spared the worst of the plagues, the death of the firstborn. That plague finally forced Pharaoh's hand and set the people free.

Jesus Christ appears in Revelation as a slain Lamb. His blood protects us from the harm of death and sets us free from sin. Through his death and resurrection, he has brought us forgiveness and opened a way for us through death to life.
