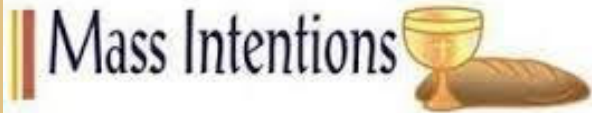

MASS ETIQUETTE ATTIRE

Remember you have entered into the house of God for the purpose of prayer, adoration, reflection or to celebrate a sacrament. Church is not the time to talk to your friends, but to talk to God.

Although the Catholic Church has no real dress code for proper attire, when attending Mass, there **IS** an unwritten dress code that demands we are properly dressed, out of respect, honor and reverence for the Real Presence of our Lord.

The idea of "Sunday Best" should be honored; churchgoers of all ages should dress appropriately.

A coat and tie for men is appropriate, but not required, a nice shirt and slacks will suffice. No hats, cutoff jeans or sleeveless Tee-shirts.

Women and young girls should wear modest dresses, skirts or slacks. No tank tops, low cut tops, short shorts, short skirts or tight-fitting clothing.

When you dress for Mass, you are not dressing to impress others, you are dressing for God.

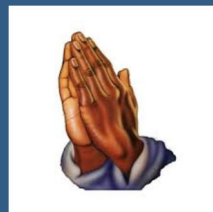
