PRAYER FOR SAFETY IN HURRICANE SEASON

The Most Reverend Glen John Provost, Bishop of Lake Charles, has asked that during the hurricane season of 2018 the people of the Diocese of Lake Charles pray the following prayer, composed in 1957 by The Most Reverend Maurice Schexnayder, Second Bishop of Lafayette, following Hurricane Audrey:

O God, Master of this passing world, hear the humble voices of your children.

The Sea of Galilee obeyed your order and returned to its former quietude.

You are still the Master of the land and sea. We live in the shadow of a danger over which we have no control: the Gulf, like a provoked and angry giant, can awake from its seeming lethargy, and overstep its conventional boundaries, invade our land and spread chaos and disaster.

During this hurricane season we turn to You, O loving Father. Spare us from past tragedies whose memories are still so vivid and whose wounds seem to refuse to heal with the passing of time. O Virgin, Star of the Sea, Our Beloved Mother, we ask you to plead with your Son in our behalf, so that spared from the calamities common to this area and animated with a true spirit of gratitude, we will walk in the footsteps of your Divine Son to reach the heavenly Jerusalem where a stormless eternity awaits us. Religious Education will show the movie, "**Romero**" in the Fr. Vecchio Hall on Thursday, June 28th at 7:00 PM.

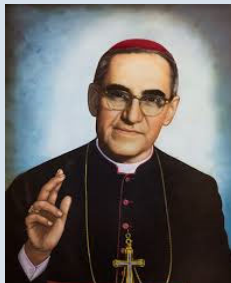

He spoke out against poverty, social injustice, assassinations and torture, which eventually cost him his life.

Archbishop Romero was assassinated on Monday March 24, 1980 as he was celebrating Mass in the chapel of the Divine Providence Cancer Hospital where he lived.

Oscar Romero was beatified by Pope Francis on May 23, 2015 and Pope Francis recently announced, in May, Oscar Romero will be canonized in October of this year and declared a saint.

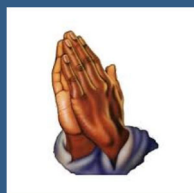
