MASS INTENTIONS

Offering a Mass for a special intention is a long standing tradition in the Catholic Church. It is usually considered that special graces are obtained for whom the Mass is celebrated. Masses are offered for many reasons; for the poor souls in Purgatory, in remembrance of someone who is deceased or in honor a loved one or friend.

If you would like a Mass Intention for someone, please contact the Parish Office. The stipend or offering given signifies the sacrificial nature of giving of something of yourself to associate more intimately with Christ who offers himself in the Eucharist. Each intention stipend is \$5.

Multiple Intentions are only offered on Saturday at the 5:00 PM Mass and Sunday at the 11:00 AM Mass. (Multiple Intentions simply means more than one Mass Intention is allowed at that Mass time.) If you request a specific date, other than a Saturday or Sunday at these Mass times, it may not be available. There is only one Mass Intention scheduled for each regular weekday Mass.

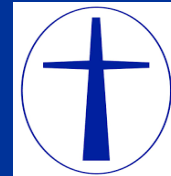

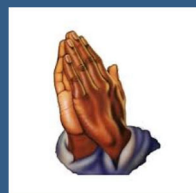

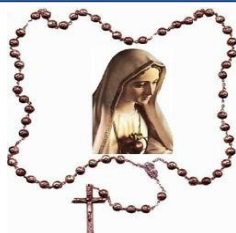
