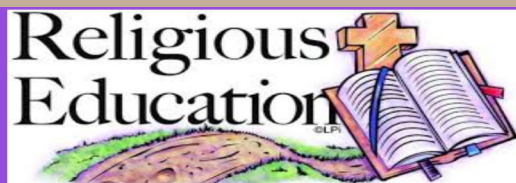

Book your reservation early.



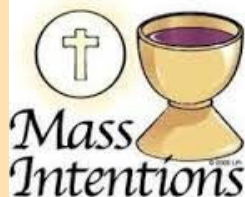

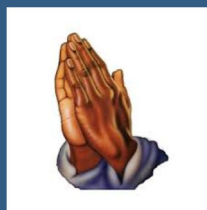
