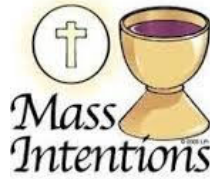
These personal tours offer prospective students and families the opportunity to tour the campus, ask questions and witness a typical day at St. Louis Catholic High School.

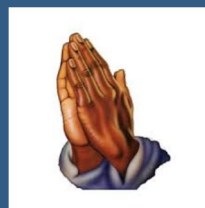
