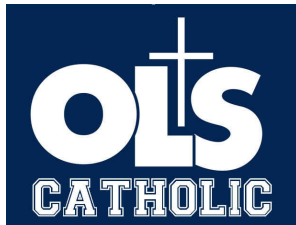
## ***OLS First Annual Glow Walk in the Park***

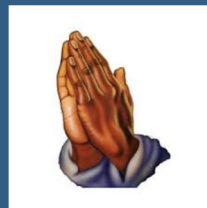
