BISHOP GLEN JOHN PROVOST

Bishop Provost was born August 9, 1949, to Cyrus and Sadie Marie Blanchet Provost in Lafayette. He received a Bachelor of Arts in English Literature from St. Joseph Seminary College in St. Benedict, LA., in 1971, studied at the North American College in Rome from 1971 to 1975, received a Bachelor of Sacred Theology (S.T.B.) from St. Thomas University in Rome in 1974 and continued studies in Sacred Theology at St. Thomas until 1975. He also earned a Master of Arts Degree in English Literature from the University of Louisiana Lafayette in 1981.

Bishop Provost was ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Lafayette by Pope Paul VI on June 29, 1975 in St Peter's Basilica in Rome. He served as an Associate Pastor at Our Lady Queen of Heaven in Lake Charles during the summer of 1975. He was Associate Pastor of St. Mary Magdalene in Abbeville, 1975-1983; Pastor of St. Leo in Roberts Cove, 1983-1985, Pastor of St. John Cathedral, 1985-1998, and Pastor of Our Lady of Fatima, 1998-March 6, 2007.

His Holiness, Pope Benedict XVI appointed him Bishop of Lake Charles on March 6, 2007. Bishop Provost was ordained to the Episcopacy and installed as the Third Bishop of Lake Charles on Monday, April 23, 2007. Our Diocese is blessed to have him.

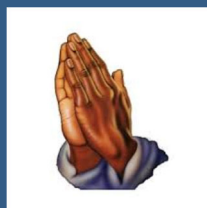
