Deacon Meeting

Parish Safety Plan

Chad Drinnen gave an update on some of the materials he has gathered regarding the Parish Safety Plan since the last meeting of Worship Commission.

In the safety plan, an individual or team needs to be appointed to be in charge if an emergency was to occur in the church or Parish Hall. It was decided that a member of the Parish Office or school staff member present at the time would be the designated individual in charge.

Emergency bins will be placed in the two sacristies, the church behind the choir wall, the family room, and the Parish Hall. The bins will include items such as lanterns, batteries, first aid kits, radios, etc. Chad will meet with Patrick Lesher to arrange for the emergency bins to be assembled.

Chad will meet with Patrick to go over the recommendations from Chief Rahe and give a report back to the commission at the next meeting.

Chief Rahe or one of his representatives will be invited to attend the next meeting of Worship Commission to address any questions the members may have. Chad will invite him to the meeting.

New Business:

It was suggested that on Easter Sunday someone should be appointed to be in charge of setup for the Masses. Mary Beth Meyer will check with John McDonald to see if he will set up for the 8:00 a.m. Easter Sunday Mass at the conclusion of the Easter Vigil Mass.
