Saint Francis Xavier Mission has utilized the original wooden church since it was built over 80 years ago. The original structure has no plumbing and minimal heating (for service only). In the mid 1960's, the parish home, hall and classroom space were added but without considering handicap accessibility.

We have renovated, remodeled, restored, and repaired the facility and continue to use the church but at a great expense. This winter after having had the bathrooms closed for a year, we installed an indoor septic system. With donated heaters, we plan to replace the worn and weary heating system this summer so we can continue to utilize the church for another 5-7 years.

Other repairs are also needed to continue to safely use the building for the short term. For many years, parishioners have felt it is time to replace! Mounting fuel bills and deferred maintenance continue to create a burden on the parish and the community.

The need is greater than ever, and the chance to make an impact even greater still! **Your contribution of time, talent, and treasure can help us to build a new church for the future of the community.**
