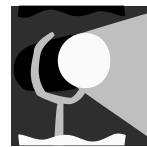
ADULT FORMATION—COMING SOON

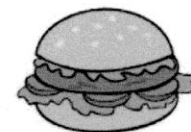
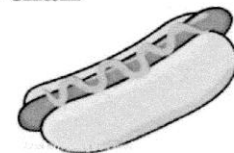

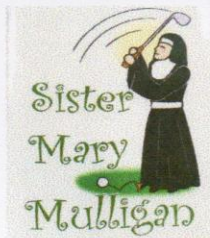
