Greetings on this the First Sunday in Lent!

February 18, 2018

This past Wednesday, we entered into another Lenten season as we were marked with blessed ashes. These ashes act to remind us of our mortality and of our responsibility to live our lives in the way of the Gospel.

Many of us think: Lent ... what should I do this year? What does it mean to me? Another season of giving something up. How do I understand it? How do my children understand it? These are all good questions!

- Lent is actually a joyful season. It's a few weeks out of the year when we can focus on ourselves and the positive changes we can try to make in our deepest selves. It's much more than giving something up for 40 days, only to start up again at some later point. This is a sacred time of the Church year. It's a time we can become more of what God wants us to be ... fully human and fully Christian.
- Lent is a time to open ourselves to changes of goodness and peace. It's a time to let go of the negatives and embrace the grace of God that is constantly pouring down upon us.
- Lent is a time to face these kinds of challenges and trials. Use this time of year to find help for yourself. A visit to the doctor's office or a heart-to-heart talk with someone who overcame his or her problems and compulsions is a good way to begin.
- Lent can be our own spiritual time in the desert where we come face-to-face with our problems and imperfections. Jesus walks with us arm in arm on our journey. We should have no fear, but instead let this sacred season bring us purity of heart, mind, and soul ... and be joyful!

As Lent begins, keep in mind the floodwaters and deserts of your own life, and remember we are never alone. The Holy Spirit is always with us. The real presence of Jesus in the Communion we share at Mass can, and will, change our lives by bringing us great joy ... all we have to do is say yes.

## Pregnancy help centers outnumber abortion centers.

According to Heartbeat International's Worldwide Directory of Pregnancy Help, there are 2,752 help locations throughout the U.S., while the Guttmacher Institute (originally founded as Planned Parenthood's research arm) reports 1,793 abortion clinics in the U.S. Six (6) out of every 10 pregnancy centers offer free ultrasounds. While it's impossible to definitively pinpoint the effectiveness of an ultrasound (given the complexity and uniqueness of each woman's journey through an unexpected pregnancy), women report life-affirming decisions the moment they meet their child through an ultrasound at a pregnancy center.
