Greetings on this Fifth Sunday of Lent.

March 18, 2018

In the Old Testament, covenant promises were commonly sealed in blood and with a sacrifice. In this weekend's first reading, Jeremiah prophesies about a "New Covenant" that God will make with His people ... the power of which will extend to the whole world. That covenant would come in the person of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The essential saving act of Jesus Christ was His shedding of His blood as a sacrifice for us. Christ suffered His passion and death on the cross so that we, every one of us, both Jew *and* Gentile, might share in God's divine life through the blood of that new covenant.

As Christians, we can enter into that new covenant in our celebration of the Mass. In the fullness of Christ's body and blood, soul and divinity that's present in the Eucharist, God shares His life with us, and offers us the opportunity to respond. And so, we make our choice. We receive the body of Christ from the table of the Lord, and the blood of Christ from the chalice of our salvation, given to us through Christ's sacrifice.

The stunning thing is that in order to provide us with His life-giving blood, Jesus had to die. This is so central to our Mass ... it's what our Mass is all about. Without it being the *real body and blood* of Christ, the Mass would only be an empty ritual. But instead, it's a connection between heaven and earth. It's the union of God's divine life with our human lives.

In the Old Testament, we found that call for union not only in the words of the prophets, but also in our obedience to and observance of God's Laws. But for most of us, that union was hard to grasp. Now, it's renewed in the blood of Christ, who, in the words of this weekend's second reading, "and when he was made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him." (Hebrews 5:9)

The Incarnation of God's Son calls us into a relationship of love, where we must know God not just with our minds, but more importantly, with our hearts. Our God is love that always seeks union with us, and the perfection of that union comes from Jesus Christ. It's a union that can't be broken even by death. Indeed, it is through Jesus' sacrificial death that we discover the perfect union God wants to have with us. This is the profound reality of the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, who continues to pursue this union with us through the blood of His cross. This is our New Covenant.

May Almighty God continue to bless you greatly.

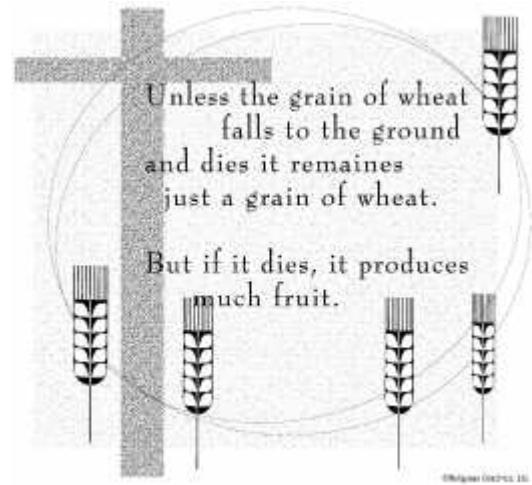

Rotate to Donate

This March, the Bemidji Community Food Shelf (BCFS) is conducting a *Rotate to Donate* collection of these boxed or canned goods. Individuals with older items can donate them to the Food Shelf and purchase newer products as needed for their own use. Qualified staff will inspect each package to determine its viability before making the goods available to clients who depend on the BCFS to feed themselves and their families.

Last year the BCFS served 10,154 individuals and 11,282 families that included 16,326 individuals 17 years old or younger.

St. Philip's will participate in the *Rotate to Donate* project with collections held prior to Masses on March 24-25. Please open your cupboards during this Easter season and Rotate to Donate food. New packaged foods or monetary donations would also be welcome.
