Happy Easter!

Something to think about....author unknown:

A young man was getting ready to graduate from college. For many months he had admired a beautiful sports car in a dealer's showroom, and knowing his father could well afford it, he told his father that was all he wanted.

As graduation day approached, the young man awaited signs that his father had purchased the car. Finally, on the morning of his graduation, his father called him into his private study and told him how proud he was to have such a fine son and how much he loved him. He handed his son a beautifully wrapped gift box.

Curious, and somewhat disappointed, the young man opened the box and found a lovely, leather-bound Bible, with his name embossed in gold. Angry, the boy raised his voice to his father and said, "With all your money you give me a Bible?" and stormed out of the house.

Don't miss God's blessings just because they are not packaged as we expect.

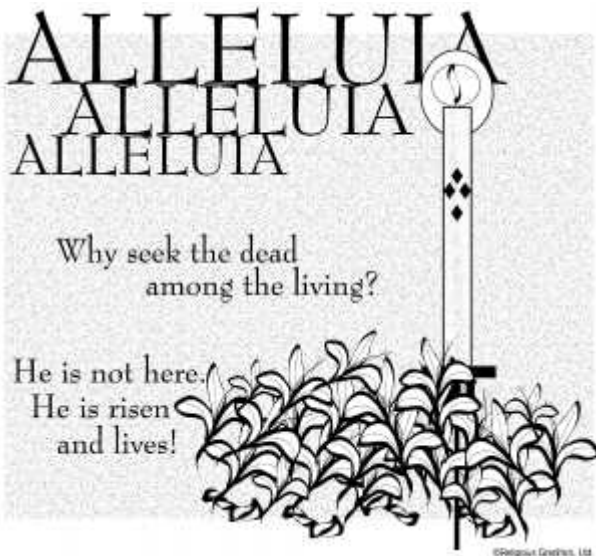

Volunteers from St. Philip's Clothing Depot held their annual meeting in March. Donations totaling \$20,000 were divided among the following charities: Bemidji Food Shelf, Senior Activity Center, Senior Nutrition Program, St. Mary's Mission in Red Lake, Northwoods Pregnancy Care Center, Evergreen House, St. Philip's Youth Ministry and St. Vincent de Paul, St. Philip's Conference. Free clothing vouchers from Churches United and St. Vincent de Paul totaled \$2,475.
