Divine Mercy Sunday Greetings,

April 8, 2018

It is a joy to announce, Fr. Bryan Kujawa will be joining the staff of St Philip's as Associate Pastor the weekend of June 30/July 1st. Fr Bryan is well known among our youth who have attended St John Paul II camp or Steubenville Summer sessions. Fr. Bryan was ordained in May 2015 and has been assigned to St Joes in Moorhead as Associate Pastor/ Director of campus ministry and the men's and women's houses of discernment. He will provide more personal information when he arrives. Please pray for all parishes that are in transition with new clergy assigned to them as of July 1st.

This is *Divine Mercy Sunday!* We know God is merciful and wants all His children with Him in Heaven. Today is a day in which you can be granted a Plenary Indulgence. This indulgence is based on the teaching that there is punishment for sin in this life and in the life to come... as an example: in this life a person may overindulge in alcohol, it can lead to relationships that are strained or broken. That punishment is a consequence of the decision to place the use of alcohol over the personal relationships. The punishment in the next life is having to see the effects that the sin had on those around us and how our example or neglect may have caused someone close to us to follow the same path or act in anger towards another. In purgatory we see the effect of our sin on others. Purgatory is a time of purification. (Catechism Catholic Church paragraphs 1030, 1031, 1032) We find it is scripturally based and it is a time when our souls are purified so that we can enter unstained into the heavenly presence. It is important to obtain the grace of a plenary indulgence when we can because this resets the timer to zero and all punishment in this life and the next are released until we do something again that warrants "time out." You are also able to "gift" your earned plenary indulgence to someone who has died.

To acquire a plenary indulgence, for *Divine Mercy*, it is necessary to desire the indulgence, attend the prayer service, and perform the following three conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intention of the Pope. It is further required that all attachment to sin, even venial sin, be absent. All the conditions must be met within a period of time, usually 8 days before or after... There are other plenary indulgences available at other times... for example those who attended the Chrism Mass could have received an indulgence if they met all the requirements. Feel free to ask Fr. Don or myself if you would like more clarification.

Here are some definitions I found: AMEN: The part of a prayer that everyone knows. BULLETIN: Your receipt for attending Mass. CHOIR: A group of people whose singing allows the rest of the Parish to lip-sync. HOLY WATER: A liquid whose chemical formula is H2O. RECESSIONAL HYMN: The last song at Mass often sung a little more quietly, since most of the people have already left. INCENSE: Holy Smoke! JONAH: The original "Jaws" story. JUSTICE: When kids have kids of their own. KYRIE ELEISON: The only Greek words that most Catholics can recognize besides gyros and baklava. MAGI: The most famous trio to attend a baby shower. MANGER: Where Mary gave birth to Jesus because Joseph wasn't covered by health insurance. PEW: A medieval torture device still found in Catholic churches. PROCESSION: The ceremonial formation at the beginning of Mass consisting of altar servers, the celebrant, and late parishioners looking for seats. RECESSIONAL: The ceremonial procession at the conclusion of Mass led by parishioners trying to beat the crowd to the parking lot. RELICS: People who have been going to Mass for so long, they actually know when to sit, kneel, and stand. TEN COMMANDMENTS: The most important Top Ten list.

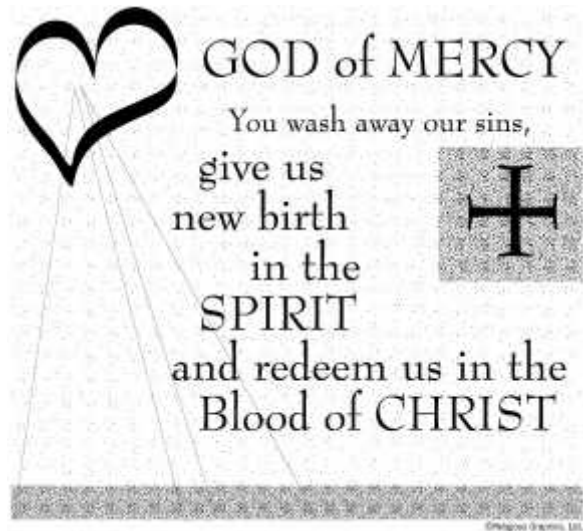
