MY TWO CENTS...by Fr. Don

May 6, 2018

Several folks asked for the author and name of the book from which I quoted in my homily last weekend. I know I forgot to get back to several who asked for the information and in the busyness after Mass I didn't write down their names.

So, the name of the book is: "When God Whispers Your Name" written by Max Lucado. He talks about how we have a dissatisfaction with life seemingly built into our hearts and God is the only one who can satisfy that dissatisfaction.

Here is the section which I quoted:

We are not happy here because we are not at home here. We are not happy here because we are not supposed to be happy here. We are "like foreigners and strangers in this world" (1 Peter 2:11).

Take a fish and place him on the beach. Watch his gills gasp and scales dry. Is he happy? No! How do you make him happy? Do you cover him with a mountain of cash? Do you get him a beach chair and sunglasses? Do you bring him a "Playfish" magazine and martini? Do you wardrobe him in double-breasted fins and people-skinned shoes?

Of course not! Then how do you make him happy? You put him back in his element. You put him back in the water. He will never be happy on the beach simply because he was not made for the beach.

And you will never be completely happy on earth simply because you were not made for earth. Oh, you will have your moments of joy. You will catch glimpses of light. You will know moments or even days of peace. But they simply do not compare with the happiness that lies ahead. Rest on this earth is a false rest.

Guard against the false physicians who promise that joy is only a diet away, a marriage away, a job away, or a transfer away. They say "It's all right, it's all right." But really, it is not all right and it won't be all right until we get home.

Again, we have our moments. The newborn on our breast, the bride on our arm, the sunshine on our back. But even those moments are simply slivers of light breaking through heaven's window. God flirts with us. He romances us. Those moments are appetizers for the dish that is to come.

This is not heaven, so don't expect it to be. There will never be a newscast with no bad news. There will never be a church with no gossip or competition. There will never be a new car, new wife, or new baby who can give you the joy your heart craves. ONLY GOD CAN!

Why is Mary honored in the month of May?

"...For centuries, the Catholic Church has set aside the entire month of May to honor Mary, Mother of God. Not just a day *in* May, mind you, but the entire month.

The custom spans both centuries and cultures, with roots going back as far as the Ancient Greeks. In early Greece, May was dedicated to Artemis, the goddess of fecundity.

In Ancient Rome, May was dedicated to Flora, the goddess of blooms, or blossoms. They celebrated *ludi florals*, or floral games, at the end of April and asked the intercession of Flora for all that blooms.

In medieval times, similar customs abounded, all centering around the practice of expelling winter, as May 1 was considered the start of new growth.

During this period, the tradition of *Tricesimum*, or "Thirty-Day Devotion to Mary," came into being. Also called, "Lady Month," the event was held from August 15-September 14 and is still observed in some areas.

The idea of a month dedicated specifically to Mary can be traced back to baroque times. Although it wasn't always held during May, Mary Month included thirty daily spiritual exercises honoring Mary.

It was in this era that Mary's Month and May were combined, making May the Month of Mary with special devotions organized on each day throughout the month. This custom became especially widespread during the nineteenth century and remains in practice until today...."

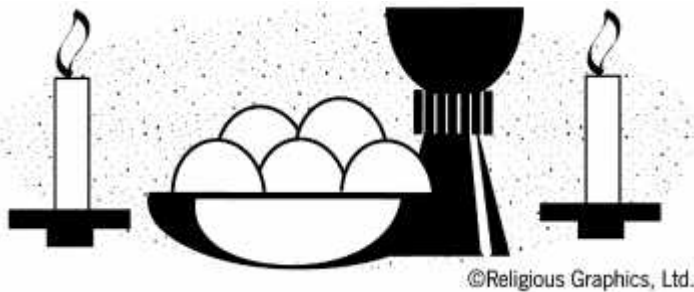

Grieving Resource Library

If you have lost a loved one, maybe you have felt one of the following during your grief: *"It can't be, it just can't be; I never knew that it would hurt so much; part of my heart has been ripped away; no one ever told me that grief felt so much like fear; no one knows the tears still inside me; and finally, death leaves a heartache no one can heal, love leaves a memory no one can steal."*

Where do I find help? At St. Philip's. We have started to develop a Grieving Resource Library. We currently have 30-some books and pamphlets that could help you through your grief of the loss of a loved one.

Some of the books we carry are:

Too Soon A Memory, a guide for parents suffering a miscarriage. This booklet focuses on the needs of parents who have to deal with a loss that involved tangible memories. **Journey Through Grief**, a series of four books: Book one, *A Time to Grieve*, the three N's, normal, natural, necessary. Book two, *Experiencing Grief*, when your loss sinks in, accepting your grief, secondary losses. Book three, *Finding Hope and Healing*, how much longer God? How long does this last? Book Four, *Rebuilding and Remembering*, permission to grieve – again, the first anniversary, rebuilding your life, continuing bonds.

The books/pamphlets are located in the St. Kateri room and can be checked out for 2 weeks or more if you need to. If you are not sure which book could assist you, contact either Fr. Chuck, Fr. Don, Deacon Kermit or Deacon Robb. *"The journey of grieving takes you from loving in the presence to loving in the absence."*
