With praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God, our diocese has reason to celebrate. This weekend, Saturday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, Deacon Nathan Brunn was ordained to the priesthood, and is now Father Nathan Brunn. Bishop Hoepfner has assigned Fr. Nate to St. Joseph's in Moorhead. Please pray for God to bless Fr. Nate in his priesthood.

This coming Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, Michael Arey will be ordained to the Sacred Order of Deacons. Deacon Michael will spend part of his summer with us here at St. Philip's. 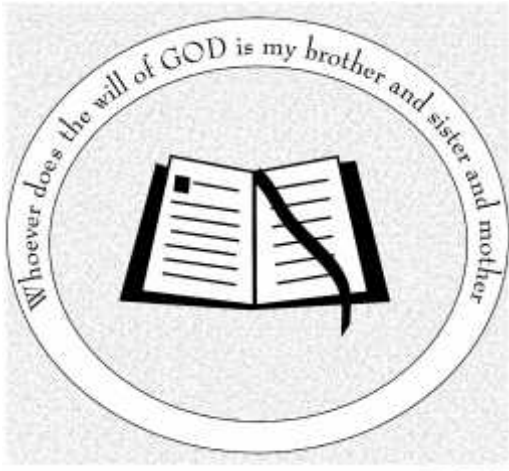
