Greetings on the Feast of the Nativity of John the Baptist,

"You, child, will be called prophet of the Most High, for you will go before the Lord to prepare his way." The Alleluia verse from this week applies to all of us, whenever we share news of Jesus with others. We do not know if the story we tell, or the encounter with God we share will bear fruit... but we trust in God, that it will serve His purpose. We may not see significance in the event but it carries forth. Recently in St Cloud: I was told a story about a little boy who had tasted an unseparated host and he told his mom "he had tasted the Lord, and He tasted like cardboard... The story that started here at St Philip's was making its rounds touching hearts and conversation ... I wondered how many people had heard and shared the story...

People share with Fr. Don and I stories about encountering Jesus in everyday life. When we review our day, we can see God in action or when we sit in silence and listen we can hear God at work, talking to His creation. Have you shared a story of where you saw or heard Jesus in our world, in this time and in this place? Please share one this week... and the Alleluia verse rings true for you!

We encounter Jesus at every Mass: A danger in our noisy, busy world is that we may take the Eucharist for granted. When we walk up the communion aisle we should ask ourselves: How will this encounter with the Body, and Blood of Jesus change me? Our faith tells us we encounter Jesus. Receiving the Eucharist, we are called to change whatever it is in our life that does not reflect the way Jesus calls us to live. He desires us to be holy, happy, and healthy people. It is important that we do not confuse the gift and the giver.

Here is a quote from *The Gift and the Giver* by Edward Farrell:

We ask for a piece of sand and he gives us a beach.

We ask for a drop of water and he gives us an ocean.

We ask for time and he gives us life eternal.

And it is so easy for us to fall in love with the gift and forget the giver.

As we near the end of our fiscal year (this week is it) it is important to look back and examine: what have we accomplished, how we have done... In the next few weeks all parish families will receive a report on: finances, statistics on number of sacraments we have celebrated, the number of parishioners we have buried. I was wondering to myself: how much of this information will really matter 100 years from now or at the end of time. Then Jesus led me to this wonderful article printed in Bruderhof regarding: "The Question" by Henri J.M. Nouwen.

"Our lives as we live them seem like lives that anticipate questions that never will be asked. It seems as if we are getting ourselves ready for the question "How much did you earn during your lifetime?" or "How many friends did you make?" or "How much progress did you make in your career?" or "How much influence did you have on people?" or "How many conversions did you make?"

Were any of these to be the question Christ will ask when he comes again in glory, many of us could approach the judgment day with great confidence. But nobody is going to hear any of these questions. The question we all are going to face is the question we are least prepared for. It is: "What have you done for the least of mine?" As long as there are strangers; hungry, naked, and sick people; prisoners, refugees, and slaves; people who are handicapped physically, mentally, or emotionally; people without work, a home, or a piece of land, there will be that haunting question from the throne of judgment: "What have you done for the least of mine?"

Jesus loves you and so do I. Blessings on your day! *Fr. Chuck*
