My Two Cents by Fr. Don

My Dear Friends,

This weekend marks the end of the biggest chapter of my life...32 years of ministry as a Priest in the Diocese of Crookston.

I will still be a Priest but the "look" of my service will be very different. I know, in the end, MY service to YOU will be letting YOU serve ME...that is why I plan to stay in Bemidji until the ALS has run its course. I love it here and you are the ones who made that happen!

"Retirement" will not sink in, I know, for some time. I also know I have no choice but to back off, slow down, and keep things simple. The public celebration of Mass, so central to the life of any Priest, ends soon as my body weakens but I will still celebrate Mass in private. Actually, NEXT weekend I will be a "sub" for Fr. Bryan who will be helping out at St. John Paul II Camp.

So many memories from so many parishes and so many good people. What an incredible honor it has been for this farm boy from New York Mills to step into the lives of people I have come to love all across the Diocese.

People ask what my greatest memory or moment of Priesthood has been. First and foremost is the celebration of the Mass when the Creator of all things comes to rest in my hands! How does a person put that into words? God humbles himself to trust a sinner to bring his Son to the world...uffda! "Lord, I am not worthy that you should come under my roof..."

In the end, all I can say is THANK YOU to God, to the Church, to my family, friends and all whose lives I have been a part of in one way or another.

One last request. Something that would be a great comfort to me is to know my ministry inspired "Random Acts of Kindness" among those I have served. We are ALL priests of Jesus Christ through our Baptism, called to offer sacrifices to God for the good of others. If you have the opportunity (today or this week or this summer or more than once) to deliberately perform a "random act of kindness" tell me about it!
