From the desk of Aana Freihammer:

I've always had a contentious relationship with the saints. They intimidate me, like the cool kids in the room with standards that I could never achieve. The saints are probably meant to impress and inspire, but I feel like I am looking at perfectly chiseled models on the magazine rack in the grocery store. They feel too lofty, too perfect, and frankly, un-relatable.

As I grew and read more about the saints, I found that many saints documented periods of doubt and darkness in their lives. I had no idea that the saints had episodes where they questioned their beliefs. After Mother Theresa was canonized a saint, private letters were published detailing some of her dark experiences "I am told God lives in me," she wrote in 1957, "and yet the reality of darkness and coldness and emptiness is so great that nothing touches my soul." Learning this about the saints made them more relatable. They were saints not because they were perfect, but because they weathered the storms of doubt.

While even saints have doubts, I think doubts in our 'everyday world' look a little different. Maybe you doubt the Catholic Church has its act together and is acting with the Holy Spirit. Maybe you wonder if God is really working in our modern culture. Maybe you question whether God really loves you and has forgiven your sins. Maybe you have deeply conflicted questions about Catholic teachings. These are also crises of faith, even if they don't look the same.

As we honestly confront these real doubts and questions, we can learn from the saints. Even though saints wondered if God was even with them, or loved them in their darkest hours, they stayed in the Church, they kept coming to Mass. They stayed in dialogue and friendship with God, even if the conversation got messy. Through their conflicted hearts, through their failings, they stayed in the Church, and stayed praying.

How do we remain steadfast in our challenges? What do we do at Mass when we have these doubts or questions? First, it's important to still come to Mass. Being with community and entering into dialogue with God is the only way through the storm. It is okay to come to Mass if you are struggling, you don't have to receive communion, just come and pray where you are. You are not going to receive any easy answers, but you will have the ritual to get you through. In the liturgy, you will hear the story of salvation, proof that God is always present in our lives, in every age. You will meet others facing the same struggles as you, and become inspired by their faith. You will experience Christ in the Eucharist, to give you heavenly food for the journey.

Finally, I couldn't end my bulletin article without one of my favorite stories of St. Theresa of Avila which shows her humanity on her path to holiness.

One day, Theresa was riding a donkey, visiting some of the monasteries she founded. It had been raining, and the donkey lost its footing in the soft earth. Theresa fell to the ground, looked to God and retorted "If this is how you treat your friends, no wonder you don't have many!"

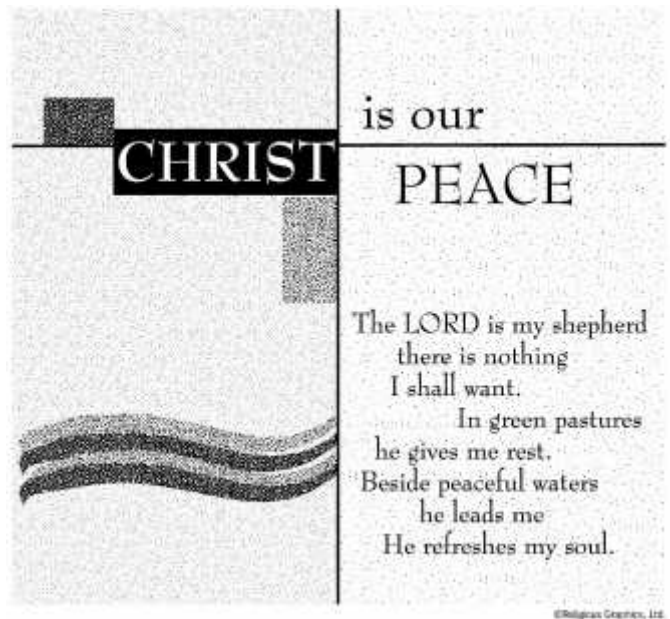

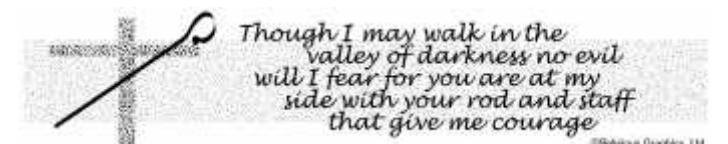
