From the desk of Fr. Bryan...

August 5, 2018

The month of August usually signifies the end of the summer. After all, school shopping usually gets started, sports practices begin, most colleges begin toward the end of the month, and so on. For those who aren't big fans of school, it can be a pretty sad time. For those who love school, or who love sending their kids off to school, it's among the most exciting times of the entire year.

August is one of my favorite months, but not because summer is nearly over. August is one of my favorite months because of all that we celebrate throughout the month in the life of the Church. Of course we know that there are many lives of the saints that we celebrate during the course of the year (we'll talk about those in a moment), but each month also has its own devotion attached to it. For example, the month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Church has dogmatically proclaimed Mary to have been conceived without sin, which is different from you and me. After the Fall - when Adam and Eve rebelled against God in the Garden of Eden - every human person born has inherited the stain of Original Sin. We all have this tendency toward sin and are born outside of a graced relationship with God. Mary, however, was preserved from the sin, since she was to be the Mother of God's only begotten Son, Jesus the Messiah. Many parents will say their newborn babies are 'perfect'. Those newborns may be so wonderful to behold, but they all have the stain of Original Sin, so they aren't quite perfect. Mary, conceived without this stain, actually is perfect in every way! During this entire month we as Catholics are invited to pay special honor to Mary's Immaculate Heart through various ways. It may be a good idea to pray a rosary more frequently throughout this month, spending time with Mary as you meditate upon the life of Jesus. Another good idea could be to learn a new Marian prayer, such as the Memorare, the Hail Holy Queen, or another one - all of them pay honor to her role as the Mother of God and ask her to pray for us and win for us many graces from God.

Another great part of this month of August involves all of the saints we get to remember. The saints, as you know, are the holy men and women who have gone before us and have shown us how to live authentically Christian lives. These men and women have given their lives to Jesus Christ and have followed his way rather than their own. They are powerful witnesses for us to learn about as each one of us strives to live for Jesus and follow his ways. This month we have some real powerhouse saints. We have a mother and son combination toward the end of the month with St. Monica (27th) and St. Augustine of Hippo (28th) - talk about a radical conversion story - he was an atheist and had a child out of wedlock and ended up being one of the greatest bishops the Church has ever seen! We also have a very holy priest who traded places in a starvation bunker in Auschwitz during WWII - St. Maximilian Kolbe (14th). We have perhaps the greatest diocesan priest ever in St. John Vianney (4th) and a man who started a religious order in St. Dominic (8th). We have a saint who was the voice of Europe and whose writings were so powerful and eloquent that many thought he should have lived in an earlier time period - St. Bernard of Clairvaux (20th). We have the first female Franciscan in St. Clare (11th) and two very powerful feast days for Mary - her Queenship (22nd) and the Assumption (15th, which is also a **Holy Day of Obligation** - see you at Mass!). I wish I had space to talk about these and all of the rest of them for this month! It's certainly a powerful time for us to rejoice in the lives of the saints and rejoice in the motherly protection of Our Lady! I hope you have a very holy month growing closer to the Lord.

May the Lord give you his peace!

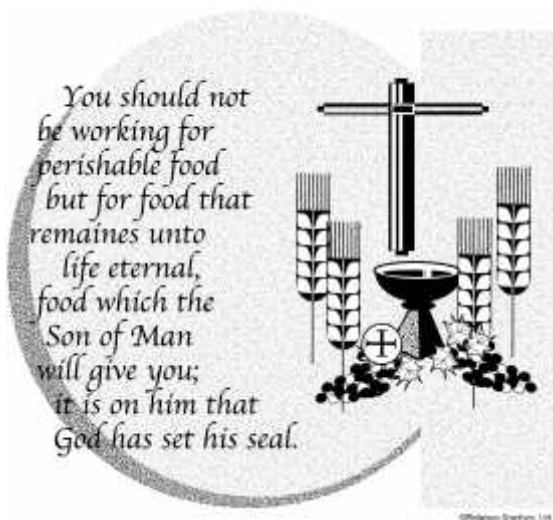
