Twenty-fourth Sunday Greetings,

September 16, 2018

The story of Peter, with all its twists and turns, is a story that every Christian can learn from.

I'm sure we could all agree that Peter is a great saint. Many of us can see ourselves reflected in his imperfect humanity and find hope in the fact that, regardless of all his struggles, in the end, he became a saint. But what makes Peter a great saint isn't his imperfections, but his deep faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. It is the fact that through this faith, Peter was able to embrace the truth of Jesus' words: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me."

We see this truth borne-out when we remember that it was Peter who denied and deserted Jesus in his time of need. In that instance, the one who declared Jesus to be the Messiah showed himself instead to be a fair-weather friend. Peter's misunderstanding of Jesus and His mission was such that he even felt himself in a position to rebuke Him. But in one of the more surprising Gospel interactions, Jesus reprimands Peter in the strongest way saying: "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." These were certainly strong words! But Peter deserved them because after all the time he had spent with Him, he still wasn't on the same page as Jesus. He hadn't yet shed his human way of thinking.

As we hear this weekend's Gospel, it's good for us to ask ourselves what *we* believe about Jesus. If we only see Him as a prophet, can we truly believe in the reconciliation offered through His Cross and Resurrection? Or ... are we like Peter, happy to confess that He is the Christ but unable to get our arms around the fullness of what that means?

If we really want to be like Peter, we need to understand his whole story ... his tearful regret after his denial of Jesus ... his declarations of love at the Sea of Galilee, and later, the courage it took to preach Christ's resurrection and ascension. These are the things that make Peter great ... these are the things that make Peter deserving of our admiration. We can learn a lot from Peter. And even though we might be attracted by his flawed humanity, we can't ignore the work that God accomplished in strengthening and empowering Peter to be a true disciple and powerful evangelist.

Just like Peter, *we also* need to allow Christ to change *us* if we're going to cast off the human way of thinking. Not easy ... but necessary. Our baptism is where our relationship with Christ began ... and it's a lifelong relationship that calls us to be always open to Christ and His Word.

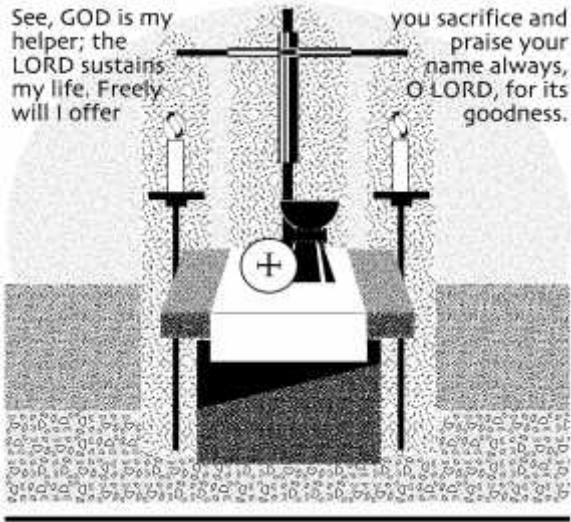
