September 30, 2018

The Gift of Life... we enter October which we call "Respect Life" month. Each week we will be giving you articles to read and contemplate. This Sunday's readings carried a message that asked us: **Who's actions or opinions do I consider not worthy of taking seriously? Sometimes we think that God's spirit reflects ours instead of our spirit reflecting God's.** When the disciples wanted to stop someone from doing good in the name of Jesus, He pointed out that it is not the membership that matters but that they are bearing fruit... good fruit. We are called to broaden our horizons and let God's spirit work in the world.

Respect Life calls to mind how every interaction every day matters. We are a people designed for relationship... deep relationships. When I surf the web and look at postings and comments by people I notice there is an underlying current of frustration... there is a sort of anger that seems to fill the comments in a negative way. I have asked myself many times: why is society like that? Why do we put our thoughts and opinions above and ahead of the thoughts and opinions of others? Whatever happened to listening and sharing in a civilized manner?

I love to save quotes from various writers and I found this one that has deep meaning for our parish. It is a way in which we can show respect for the life of another person. It was entitled: *What's Wrong with Gossip?* By Eberhard Arnold. There is no law but love. Love is joy in others. Therefore, it should be out of the question to speak about another person in a spirit of irritation or vexation. There must never be talk, either in open remarks or by insinuation, against anyone, or against their individual characteristics—and under no circumstances behind their back. Gossiping in one's family is no exception. Direct address is the brotherly or sisterly service we owe anyone whose weaknesses cause a negative reaction in us. An open word spoken directly to another person can deepen friendship. (Let us pray for peaceful conversations with the Lords help...)

Another story to illustrate the point of not seeing the other person but our own issue and side: *Look Ma, No Arms!* A man spoke with the Lord about heaven and hell. The Lord said to the man, "Come, I will show you hell." They entered a room where a group of people sat around a huge pot of stew. Everyone was famished, desperate and starving. Each held a spoon that reached the pot, but each spoon had a handle so much longer than their own arm that it could not be used to get the stew into their own mouths. The suffering was terrible. "Come, now I will show you heaven," the Lord said after a while. They entered another room, identical to the first - the pot of stew, the group of people, the same long-handled spoons. But there everyone was happy and well-nourished. "I don't understand," said the man. "Why are they happy here when they were miserable in the other room and everything was the same?" The Lord smiled, "Ah, it is simple," he said. "here they have learned to feed each other."

Be Good, Be Safe, Be Loving, Be Kind, Be Gentle, Be Compassionate, Behave, and if you do not... remember that is why we have reconciliation... so tell me about it...

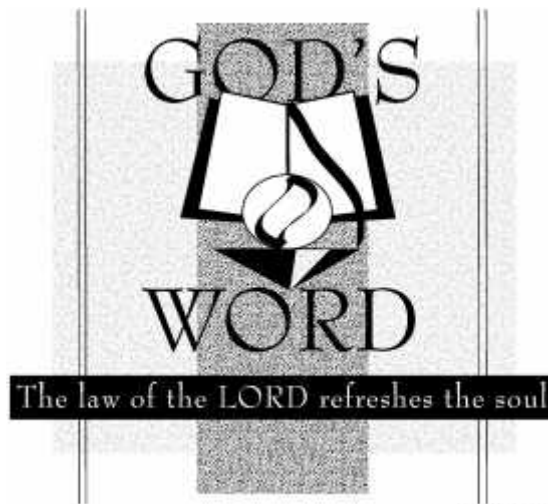
