From the Desk of Fr. Bryan...

October 7, 2018

The month of October is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Rosary, which is a great way for us to pray and meditate on the life of Jesus through the eyes of his Blessed Mother. An entire rosary consists of 20 "decades" - the Our Father once, the Hail Mary ten times, and a Glory Be. During each decade, we meditate on one of the various mysteries in the life of Jesus. Typically, people will take a set of five mysteries and spend their time with that, rather than praying through the entire set of 20. The mysteries include the early life of Jesus (the Joyful Mysteries), the public life of Jesus (the Luminous Mysteries), the Passion of Jesus at the end of his life (the Sorrowful Mysteries), and the life of Jesus and his disciples after the Resurrection (the Glorious Mysteries). It truly is a great way to pray with the life of Jesus! I'd encourage you to give it a shot, even if you've never prayed the rosary before. Take some time a few days this month to pray the rosary, meditating on the life of Jesus and asking his Blessed Mother to pray for you while you do it. The set of five mysteries will take about 15-20 minutes, which is perfect for your amount of prayer time each day. If you're daring, you can pray with five mysteries of the rosary each day this month: Joyful Mysteries on Mondays and Saturdays; Luminous Mysteries on Thursdays; Sorrowful Mysteries on Tuesdays and Fridays; and Glorious Mysteries on Wednesdays and Sundays. This is a prayer that was very popular in the past, but has fallen out of practice in recent years. Let's get back into it by asking the Mother of God to pray for us in this great way.

Now, here are some of the saints we remember during this month: We've already remembered some great ones up to this point: the patron saint of missionaries is a nun who never left her convent, St. Thérèse (Oct 1st), the saint who is widely believed to have been the most like Jesus is on the 4th, St. Francis of Assisi (he may have loved animals, but he clearly loved Jesus far more, so let's remember him for this reason), the one who received the Divine Mercy image, St. Faustina, is on the 5th, and the founder of the Carthusian monks on the 6th, St. Bruno. Today, October 7th, is annual celebration of Our Lady of the Rosary (surpassed by the Sunday liturgies, so we don't hear about it). Looking into the future, there are some real gems on the calendar. We'll start with the holy men: four very early Christians, including one of the Gospel writers and two of the Apostles, in St. Luke (18th), Sts. Simon and Jude (28th), and St. Ignatius of Antioch (17th); two excellent popes in St. John XXIII (11th) and St. John Paul II (22nd); among even more, the last ones we'll mention are the North American Martyrs (19th), who were Jesuit missionaries in America preaching the Gospel to Iroquois and Huron people between Nova Scotia and Maryland. Ten years after they were martyred, a little girl was born who went on to become St. Kateri Tekakwitha. Their work bore fruit beyond their lives!

We also have some very powerful and holy women to remember this month: besides those already mentioned above, we have a great reformer of the Carmelites in St. Teresa of Avila (15th), a woman who was a wife and then became a contemplative nun after her husband died and whose niece was St. Elizabeth of Hungary, St. Hedwig (16th), and on the same day a nun who received powerful images and messages from Jesus about his Sacred Heart, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque.

The saints can be such a great inspiration for us! They can show us how to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus in the midst of a world that is trying to push away from him. I really encourage you to look some of them up and learn more about their lives. Together with the Blessed Mother, they lead us along the straight and narrow way to life everlasting. What a glorious month we have before us! Perhaps some of us may be included among the saints whose lives are remembered during the month of October. Let's pray for each other as we strive for Heaven.

May the Lord give you his peace!
