Happy Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time:

**October 14, 2018**

Today's gospel reading from Mark, begins with Jesus being asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

The first part of his answer seems fairly easy to do, just follow these commandments, you shall not kill, you shall not commit adultery, you shall not steal..., honor your father and mother. Like the man in the gospel, I can handle that. But then Jesus adds, "you are lacking in one thing. I would also like to encourage each of you to make this one of your top issues when deciding who you should vote for in the upcoming elections. Please find out the position of each candidate in regards to life issues and make this a strong consideration on whether or not you give them your vote.

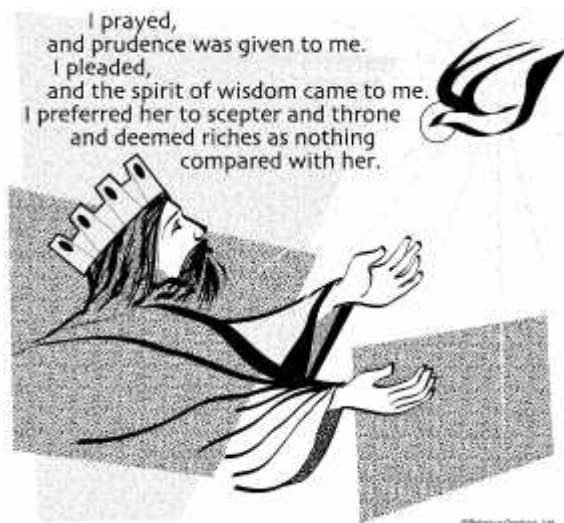
