Our giving tree is up and being generously responded to by the Parish. Tubs of Love have been collected to give food and gifts to needy families. We're all scrambling to find gifts for our loved-ones, and we wonder if our generosity will be well-received. Are our gifts meaningful enough? Did we spend enough money? Sound familiar?

We're reminded in the gospel (*Matthew 7:11*) these words of Our Lord: "If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good things to those who ask him?" How much more so does God, who is infinitely good, want to give us an abundance of His grace!

What does this mean for us at Christmas? The Child Jesus came into the world to GIVE. And because of this, we must ask for the greatest of graces! We must be bold and ask for everything that we need for ourselves and our loved ones. We also must be willing to be as generous as we can for those around us who are in need, especially for the poor and for strangers. And, we're assured that our giving and our drawing closer to our God will bring us great joy.

Christian joy comes from a divine encounter with God's unconditional love, and mercy, that compels us to seek and share the Good News enthusiastically. In a world filled with struggle and conflict, the warm smile we see on our Pope Francis' bears witness to true Christian joy, founded in the Good News that God is present among us. Pope Francis reminds us by his words, gestures, and tender glance that joy and generosity are at the heart of our Christian lives, and that we as Christians are compelled to share our joy and be generous with others. As Pope Francis writes, "Our joy in God generates missionary enthusiasm," which we must communicate to everyone we encounter.

In our spiritual lives, we're called to claim and promote encounters with God's unconditional love, mercy, and freedom. We do this in the sacraments, Scriptures, prayer, our generosity to others and by corporal works of mercy. God promises that if we trust in him through prayer, petition, and thanksgiving, He will reward us with grace and peace.

The witness of our Pope Francis reminds us that the world is hungry for the freedom and peace found in Christian joy. God calls to us every day to bask in and share the joy that results from our divine encounter with God's unconditional love, mercy, and liberation. May our joyous hearts be generous in our giving and spread love throughout the world to everyone we meet.

## A Call to Feed the Hungry

I would like to thank the more than 50 volunteers from St. Philip's who make a significant impact on the *Bemidji Community Food Shelf*. Our parishioners freely give their time helping customers select food, interviewing clients, working in the warehouse, driving trucks, collecting donations from area merchants, serving food at fundraisers, harvesting vegetables from the organization's farm, cleaning fruit, managing compost efforts, and performing many other tasks. One of the founding churches of the Food Shelf decades ago, St. Philip's has done much to support individuals and families who need food just to survive.

We are now being called to do more, and with your help we will.

A smaller church provided volunteers to work mornings on the first Wednesday of each month. It is no longer able to do so. For the past several months, Food Shelf staff has struggled to fill the time slot. After discussing this with many of our volunteers, it was decided that St. Philip's would take over this opportunity. As a result, each month our parish will staff the morning of the first Wednesday as well as on the mornings and afternoons of the fourth Monday.

More volunteers will be required to fill these times, especially since one-third of our volunteers head to warmer weather from January through March.
