Greetings on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent and the Eve of Christmas.

December 23, 2018

Life is Advent and the anticipation has built to this point in time: Christmas. The church proper is about to undergo a change in environment. Have we had a change in our interior environment as well? We are about to celebrate the birthday of Jesus. Advent is about our expressing our belief just like Mary did. "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled." (Luke 1:45) I am excited for this day! Not only because it is Christmas, but it means that God has kept His word and His Son is among us.

Christmas is a feast for the eyes. We hardly know where to look first. The church is alive with all the symbols of Christmas celebration. Even before we enter we see signs of the season at the entrances of the church. The manger scene is a magnet for the children to come and see. The sanctuary is filled with light. All Advent we have been praying for Christ's coming. The candles proclaim Christ, the light of the world. Candles are meant to remind us that Christ is in our midst because we are gathered in his name. The words of the ancient "O come, let us adore Him!" remind us that we are here to give glory to God. Stop, look and listen! The Lord is in our midst! By all means look around and then look within your own heart ... to find an even more profound presence of the God who came to be one with us.

Christmas is a time of great hospitality. There is a story about someone who once complained to the priest that whenever he came to church the music was always the same: "Silent Night" or "Christ the Lord is Risen Today." Those of you who are here Sunday after Sunday can be a welcoming presence to those who come to church only on Christmas and Easter. Our hospitality can be a powerful way of saying, "We're glad you're here. Please join us every Sunday for worship." Our hospitable friendliness can be a powerful tool of evangelization, reaching out to those who do not feel regularly connected to a parish.

For some reason this year I am drawn to thoughts about those who are missing a loved one. Someone in the family or a close friend has died, and this will be the first year without their physical presence. It can be very hard. There is inside us a hint of sadness when we know there should be great joy. A comforting thought to me is that the person is in heaven for the great feast of the Nativity. I realize that my pain and hurt is somehow a reflection of my sense of loss, my personal sense of being alone, without them. When thoughts turn towards the other and I realize what a great gift they have received in the salvation promised by our Lord and Savior, I realize I can have joy in their new-found joy, and peace in their new-found peace at being in the presence of God. When my friend, my relative is at peace then I can also be at peace, it is all centered in the Love of God so strong for us that He came to be one of us and bring us into the heavenly kingdom.

Merry Christmas! Enjoy the gift of Jesus! Bring Him home and let Him loose in your house, family, work and neighborhood. I Love you!
