Feast of Holy Family Greetings,

December 30, 2018

This last Sunday in 2018 is an important one. We celebrate the feast of the Holy Family. The devil has his eye on your family and would like to cause chaos. Use the grace of God to keep the devil from your doorstep. Bless your children daily. Hold each other in prayer and treat each other with dignity. Talk in a civil manner to each other and say please and thank you. It is with the family that either of my favorite expressions can be used: *I love you because...* or *I prayed for you today, and I asked God to...*

This might also be a valuable time to consider looking closely at your personal image of the Holy Family. As you contemplate the Holy Family, what do you envision? Are our own personal families reflective of the family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph? Is our parish family? In what way? Are we adaptive like Joseph, open like Mary, loving like Mary and Joseph? Do we face hostility because of choices we have made? Do we follow God's plan?

It may seem that, the earthly lives of Jesus, Mary and Joseph are far removed from our own today. But if we think about it, maybe we will feel an invitation to grow in our own humanity and holiness. God invites us to join him, to follow his will, to create with him. But the decision is always up to us.

I also have found a suggestion that we could adapt as a goal for us as a parish family in the New Year. It is done as a paraphrase of the Prayer of St. Francis. It asks that in our parish family we might grow as the instruments of the Lord's presence as part of our New Year's resolutions. (Read it slowly and out loud. Since we are familiar with the prayer of St Francis we might say the wrong words)

*Lord, make our parish the instrument of your presence.
Help us to depend not on collections and committees but on a lively faith.
Keep us open to build bridges between people, and not isolate into factions.
Guide us to find words that encourage and affirm rather than criticize or belittle.
Give us the sensitivity to listen to the needs and hurts of others and
not to react with cynicism or selfishness.
For we believe that it is ours to build community, where there is isolation,
To proclaim gospel wholeness where there is brokenness,
And to replace the shallow promises made by our world with the promise
and the presence of the Risen Lord.*

Here is a prayer of blessing to be said with or over your family:

*We bless your name, O Lord, for sending your own incarnate Son to become part of a family,
so that, as he lived its life, he would experience its worries and its joys.
We ask you, Lord, to protect and watch over this family, so that in the strength of your grace
its members may enjoy prosperity, possess the priceless gift of your peace, and, as the Church alive
in the home, bear witness in this world to your glory. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

Please remember: We celebrate the feast of the Holy Family. The devil has his eye on your family and would like to cause chaos. Use the grace of God to keep the devil from your doorstep. May God bless you and your family with a Holy, Healthy, and Happy New Year.

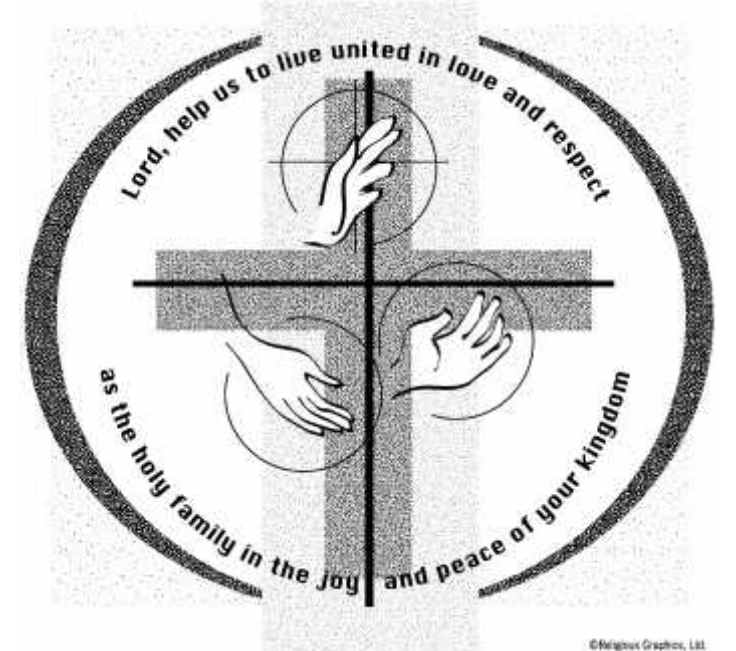

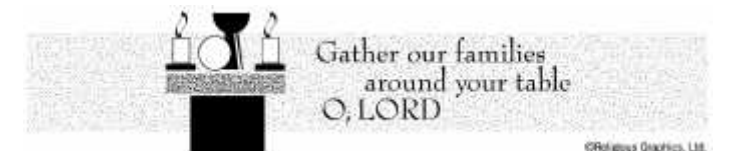
