I wish I could place myself in the gospel reading for this weekend. On the shores of an open lake. Not by a frozen lake with all the snow that we have around here! 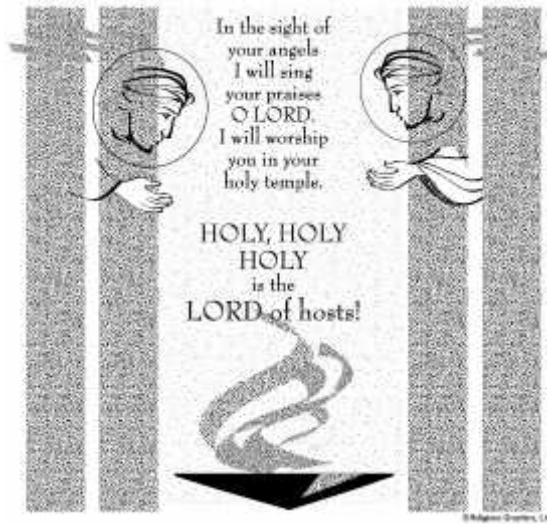
